Improvements to public right of way between Ascot Way & Mill Lane

The Parish Council has successfully secured funding to facilitate improvements to the surface of the aforementioned bridleway which will allow residents of South Hykeham easier and more sustainable access to North Hykeham and vice versa. At present the two are mainly connected by roads, many of which do not have pavements making a car the only real safe means to travel between the two. The idea is to provide a safe and pleasant connection between North and South Hykeham which can easily be traversed by foot, cycle or on horseback in order to access the school at South Hykeham and a wider range of local services. Whilst the Parish Council has made some provision in its own budget for these improvements the project was reliant upon a successful grant funding bid or matched funding from a partner organisation.

Access Lincoln has agreed to match fund the project and in addition the Parish Council is delighted to announce that it has recently been selected to be a Lincolnshire Co-operative Society's Community Champion for the environment quarter. During the threemonth period of June to September 2019, money is raised through people with a South Hykeham postcode shopping at their local Co-op store on Newark Road and using their dividend card, in-store fundraising and carrier bag levy with a share of the funds raised being awarded to successful projects such as the Bridleway improvements.

The Parish Council is currently preparing to go through a tender process in accordance with its Financial Regulations to secure the services of a suitably qualified contractor who will be engaged following that process in order to carry out the approved works. It is hoped that the resurfacing will be completed by March 2020.

The Police Beat Team has been carrying out enforcement at various locations where there is evidence of excessive speed and failure to comply with the speed limits in force.
