Improvements to public right of way between Ascot Way & Mill Lane

The Parish Council has successfully secured funding to facilitate improvements to the surface of the aforementioned bridleway which will allow residents of South Hykeham easier and more sustainable access to North Hykeham and vice versa. At present the two are mainly connected by roads, many of which do not have pavements making a car the only real safe means to travel between the two. The idea is to provide a safe and pleasant connection between North and South Hykeham which can easily be traversed by foot, cycle or on horseback in order to access the school at South Hykeham and a wider range of local services. Whilst the Parish Council has made some provision in its own budget for these improvements the project was reliant upon a successful grant funding bid or matched funding from a partner organisation.

Access Lincoln has agreed to match fund the

project and in addition the Parish Council been selected to be a Lincolnshire Co-operative Society's Community Champion for the environment quarter.

During the three-month period of June to September 2019. Money is raised through people with a South Hykeham postcode shopping at their local Co-op store on Newark Road and using their dividend card and instore fundraising and carrier bag levies. Representatives of the Parish Council were presented with a cheque at Gibraltar Point Nature Reserve.

It is hoped that work on the resurfacing will be commencing shortly and should be completed by March 2020.

Overgrown tress and hedges

Did you know that where hedges and trees grow on the edge of the highway or footpath and mark its boundary with private property, it is the responsibility of the adjacent landowner/occupier to maintain them?

It has come to the attention of the Parish Council that in some places there are overgrown hedges and trees which are starting to pose a danger to the safe passage of traffic and pedestrians, or where visibility is impaired by overhanging foliage.

Many families in the South Hykeham area walk to school or to the shops and we would like to

make their walk as safe as possible. Please check your hedges and boundaries and if necessary cut back overgrown foliage well back from the road or footpath.

Inconsiderate parking on pavements

The Parish Council has had a number of reports of vehicles parking on the pavements at various locations in and around South Hykeham.

Parking on the pavement can obstruct and seriously inconvenience pedestrians, people in wheelchairs or with visual impairments and people with prams or pushchairs. Please show some consideration to others when parking your vehicle.

Lincs Community Speedwatch Initiative

The Speed Indicator Device purchased by South Hykeham Parish Council has now been up and running for several months. The device has been installed at different locations throughout South Hykeham on a rolling programme and monthly reports of vehicles exceeding the speed limit in those locations have been downloaded. The Police and Road Safety Partnership have been notified of 'hotspots' and will be carrying out enforcement in order to tackle the problem.
