Improvements to public right of way between Ascot Way & Mill Lane

At the time of writing this the County Council has been advertising a temporary restriction of the bridleway between 20th July and 28th August 2020 with restrictions to be implemented for 30 days as and when required during this period for Bridleway reconstruction works. (Signage will be displayed on site in advance of the commencement of works giving accurate dates and times of the period of restriction)The works will commence at Mill Lane and continue through to Ascot Way. Alternative route/access arrangements will be signposted.

Lincs Community Speedwatch Initiative

The Speed Indicator Device is installed at different locations throughout South Hykeham on a rolling programme and monthly reports of vehicles exceeding the speed limit in those locations are downloaded. The Police and Road Safety Partnership will be advised of hotspots where excessive speeds are recorded with a view to enforcement action being taken.

Overhanging trees and hedges

Overgrown trees and hedges

Did you know that where hedges and trees grow on the edge of the highway or footpath and mark its boundary with private property, it is the responsibility of the adjacent landowner/occupier to maintain them?

It has come to the attention of the Parish Council that in some places there are overgrown hedges and trees which are starting to pose a danger to the safe passage of traffic and pedestrians, or where visibility is impaired by overhanging foliage.

Many families in the South Hykeham area walk to school or to the shops and we would like to make their walk as safe as possible. Please check your hedges and boundaries and if necessary cut back overgrown foliage well back from the road or footpath.
