#### **South Hykeham Parish Council**

It is with regret that face to face Parish Council meetings since the outbreak of COVID-19 have had to be cancelled until further notice following the advice and guidance from the National and Local Associations of Local Councils.

With effect from 10<sup>th</sup> June all council meetings have taken place remotely having been convened under The Local Authorities and Police and Crime Panels (Coronavirus) (Flexibility of Local Authorities and Police and Crime Panel Meetings) (England and Wales) Regulations 2020. The meetings will continue to take place on the second Wednesday of the month commencing at 7pm on Zoom until March 2021.

## Public right of way improvements between Ascot Way & Mill Lane

The work to reinstate and improve the public right of way between Ascot Way and Mill Lane is now well under way and will be a vast improvement to the route which for a considerable part of the year is virtually impassable due to standing water and an extremely uneven surface. South Hykeham Parish Council has worked extremely hard to successfully secure funding to facilitate improvements to the surface of the aforementioned bridleway which will allow residents of South Hykeham easier and more sustainable access to North Hykeham and vice versa. At present the two are mainly connected by roads, many of which do not have pavements making a car the only real safe means to travel between the two. The idea is to provide a safe and pleasant connection between North and South Hykeham which can easily be traversed by

foot, cycle or on horseback in order to access the school at South Hykeham and a wider range of local services and employment opportunities.

Whilst the Parish Council made some provision in its own budget for these improvements the project was reliant upon a successful grant funding bid or matched funding from a partner organisation. Access Lincoln agreed to match fund the project and in addition the Parish Council was selected to be one of Lincolnshire Co-operative Society's Community Champions (Environmental Award) Grant funding was given towards the project which was recognised as contributing towards environmental sustainability.

The works commence at Mill Lane and continue through to Ascot Way. Unfortunately it was not possible to upgrade the wooded section between Beechcroft Close and Ascot Way as there are a number of trees protected by Tree Preservation Orders and it would not have been possible to carry out work at this location without possibly compromising their wellbeing.

It is envisaged that the works will be completed by January 2021 subject to favourable weather conditions.
