WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING

Operation to tackle anti-social behaviour

Officers continue to patrol areas of North Hykeham and Lincoln to tackle anti-social behaviour (ASB). We have been teaming up with our Lincoln colleagues to staff ASB patrol vans for the school summer holidays. The patrols have responded to reports of ASB and patrol hot spot areas. Work continues with CEMEX, Hykeham sailing club and Sea Scouts in relation to the ongoing ASB at the Apex lake. We have been working closely with the NKDC ASB team, who have been sending letters out to the parents of the children that have been found swimming in the lakes.

Please ensure you talk to your children about the dangers of swimming in open water. There are risks from cold water shock, under water obstacles, vegetation, and diseases such as Weil's disease spread by rat urine. Many lakes are privately owned so they may also be trespassing.

Interviews have been held for the replacement of PC Wood who retires from the Police early next year. We are pleased to announce that there have been two successful applicants and we are awaiting the date for them to join us - Congratulations to PC Sarah Kennedy and PC Jordan Bathie-Drexler, we look forward to you joining the team soon!
