Volunteer litterpicking initiative

The Parish Council runs a programme of volunteer litterpicking events and is looking for more volunteers to join our Parish Councillors in litterpicking at hot spot areas in South Hykeham. If you are able to assist please let the Clerk have your contact details at southhykehampc@gmail.com This email address can also be used to notify the Parish Council of any areas that require attention and to report flytipping. The assembly point is at Beechcroft (entrance to Beechcroft Woods) where protective clothing and equipment will be issued to volunteers by the Parish Council. There are some children's litterpicking kits too if families would like to come along and join in. Volunteers will be covered by the Parish Council's Public Liability insurance.

Litterpicks usually take place on the second Saturday of alternate months, assembly point and times as above. The next scheduled litterpick is on Saturday 9th November 2022 (subject to weather conditions) and will start at 10.30am and last until midday.
