#### Joint Hykeham Neighbourhood Plan review

Luke Brown, the consultant who is working with the North and South Hykeham Councils on the review of the Joint Neighbourhood Plan review (NP) will be the guest speaker at the Annual Parish meeting.

Luke will be outlining the review process and inviting questions from parishioners as to how they might be involved in forming the policies at the same time ensuring they are consistent with local and national policy. Now is the opportunity to feed into this process and to see how future planning development proposals including the Hykeham Relief Road and the development of Grange Farm where around 2000 new dwellings are proposed may impact upon the community and local area. The NP covers matters such as housing, protection of green spaces, the environment and historical features all of which are important considerations when there are proposed planning developments coming forward.

The Hykeham Councils are keen to form a working party involving interested parishioners and other stakeholders in the joint review which will be led by both Councils.
