Public Right of Way improvements through Pennells & the Bentley

The bridge is owned & managed by the County Council however the land either side is managed by the respective landowners Pennells and the Bentley Hotel, who have a duty of care to make reasonable adjustments to make the land accessible to those with mobility issues.

Cllr Woodruff LCC has spoken with Mr Pennell, who has agreed to install a dropped kerb & secure pathway to the bridge, like the one already installed by the Bentley Hotel.

LCC officers have attended the site & confirmed the bridge site needs some works & vegetation clearance. Once the clearance work is complete & there has been a full assessment of the site, remedial work will be carried out to improve the access for all. With that in mind, Mr Pennell has been asked to defer installing the path & dropped kerb until the site clearance and any repairs have been completed.

At the time of writing this the lead time on the proposed works on the bridge site is about 8 weeks but Cllr Woodruff will advise the Parish Council and residents of any updates to time scales/remedial works etc.
