Replacement defibrillator for McDonalds Gateway Park site

The Parish Council has recently bought an additional defibrillator to replace the Heartsine which is housed at McDonalds Gateway Park and is available for public use through the ambulance service. The original defibrillator was bought by McDonalds and weekly checks are carried out by their staff. McDonalds very kindly provide the power supply to the locking cabinet it is housed in. This is an excellent example of partnership working.

The new defibrillator, Physio-Control CR2usb Fully Automatic Defibrillator has a higher specification and is fitted with a tracker. The Council is currently looking considering a suitable relocation site for the Heartsine.

New Noticeboards

A new Parish noticeboard has been purchased for Meadow Lane & another to replace the recently vandalised noticeboard at Thorpe Lane.
